It is a great honor to organize the 63rd FISEC Games 2011 which the current year, are going to be held from the 5th to the 11th of July.

1. PARTICIPATION

The participation on the 63th FISEC Games includes all the countries that are FISEC members and other countries which are invited by the organization and endorsed by FISEC Executive Committee.

Will only be accepted applications from students born in 1994, 1995 1996 and 1997. It will not be allowed the participation of students born in different years.

2. ORGANIZATION

The organization of the 63rd FISEC Games is assumed by the Portuguese Ministry of Education (ME) through the Directorate-General of Innovation and Curricular Development (DGIDC) and the Bureau of School Sport, in collaboration with the Regional Directorate of Education of Lisbon and Vale do Tejo (DRELVT).

5. ACCOMODATION

The delegations of the participants will be accommodated in the hotels:

These hotels are all very similar, with very pleasant facilities, that will provide an excellent accommodation for all participants.

Breakfast will be served at respective accommodation hotel.

Available rooms for the delegations are double and triple.

All the participants have to respect rules of behavior demanded to the remaining customers. The Heads of Delegation will be made responsible by the problems and disturbs, including any damage provoked for its delegation.

All STAFF from FISEC Games will be accommodated at the **Sana Metropolitan Hotel**.

5.1. Reception e Registration Procedures

The Registration procedures of the participant Delegations will be carried through in **Sana Metropolitan Hotel**. FISEC information desk also will be located in the same hotel.

6. MEALS

Feeding is from the responsibility of the organization, being that breakfast will be taken in the Hotels and lunches and suppers in students canteens.

In case of special necessities of diets exist, duly justified, the delegations must inform the organization at the moment of arrival.

7. TRANSPORTATION

Transportation between the accommodation facilities, competitions, ceremonies and cultural events will be guaranteed by the organization.

Because of the close proximity between the sports facilities and accommodation, the delegations may go on foot or use the Metro for the same purpose. In addition, the organization will provide a service "Shuttle bus" to facilitate the movement of delegations.

The transportation between the airport and the accommodation of the delegations, will cost 25€ per person, for the round trip.
